History

"H Warm Slice of Southern Charm"

In 1839, the city of Galveston, Texas was officially founded along with it, The Tremont House. Overcoming fires, hurricanes, and renovations, The Tremont House has a long, rich history. June 1865 was the year Galveston's Strand District fell victim to a great fire, leaving the Tremont in ruins for more than five years. After years of recovery, in 1872 the new Tremont House was reborn. Designed by architect Nicholas Clayton, the new house attracted elitists from all over the world with its grand 4-story structure.

Just eight months into the new century, the Tremont House was devastated by the 1900 Galveston Hurricane known as "The Great Galveston Hurricane," the deadliest natural disaster in United States history. By 1928, the second Tremont House was condemned and demolished from the effects of the hurricane and the early years of the Great Depression.

However, that was not the last of the Tremont House. Cynthia and George Mitchell were the leaders of the Galveston Historical Foundation and were advocated from preserving Galveston's history. With their help, the third Tremont House was built in 1981 and opened in 1985 during Mardi Gras celebrations.

The Tremont House today is as vibrant as ever, and still has its southern charm. It is a one-of-kind luxurious way to experience one of the most popular destinations along the Texas coast.
