

When equipment needed upgrading, installers often left old cables behind, creating a growing mess. Industry estimates suggest that 70% of network downtime stemmed from non-standardized cabling systems.

Fiber optic cabling offers the most benefits for hotels:

- Virtually unlimited bandwidth and fast speeds
- Service life of 20+ years
- Easy scalability for future needs
- Enhanced security and reliability
- Lower interference and better performance over distance

Copper cabling, such as CAT6/6A Ethernet, provides a cost-effective solution for end-to-end connections to guest rooms, although it has lower capacity than fiber and requires more frequent replacement.

Coaxial cabling has become less common in new construction, but it may still be used in specific applications, such as CCTV systems.
